Sohail Jehangir Malik is one of Pakistan's leading agriculture and development policy analysts. He has more than thirty years of international experience in policy-oriented research into development problems with a focus on agricultural development and poverty alleviation. His international experience includes agriculture policy analysis (including WTO and trade related issues), technology choice, biodiversity conservation, poverty analysis, formulation and implementation, rural finance, food security and nutrition and social safety nets. A significant part of his career has focused on the setting up and evaluation of agricultural and economic development strategies in developing countries in Africa and Asia.

He has published over one hundred articles and research reports; most of these have appeared in leading professional journals. He has written three books, edited/co-edited four others and authored chapters in eight different books. His seminal work on estimating poverty in Pakistan at the agro-climatic zone level which was published as a chapter in the internationally acclaimed 1993 book entitled *Including the Poor* edited by Michael Lipton and Jacques van der Gaag established the basis for the consideration of disaggregated regional analysis for effective agricultural and poverty reduction policy making. He has been involved in policy formulation and evaluation for all the four Provincial Governments and the Federal Government of Pakistan.

He started his career from the Pakistan Institute of Development Economics (PIDE), Islamabad in the mid 1970s and has worked in various senior positions in reputed national and international research and academic organizations. His positions have included Research Fellow and Chief of Party at the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI), Washington DC, Vice President at John Mellor Associates, Washington, D.C., Chief Executive Officer at Innovative Environmental Technologies, Inc, Virginia, and Coordinator, Poverty Cluster Operations Evaluation Department at the World Bank, in Washington, D. C. He has held the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan Chair in Economics at the University of Agriculture at Faisalabad and the University of Sargodha. He has worked in America, Africa, Asia and Australia. He has consulted for the FAO, the UNDP, the Asian Development Bank, the World Food Program and the International Trade Center of the WTO,

Currently he is Chairman of the Innovative Development Strategies (Pvt.) Ltd., a private consulting firm based in Islamabad, Pakistan and President of the Agricultural Assessments International Corporation in Maryland USA. He has been Advisor to the Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund and is currently a member of several high level international advisory committees and groups including the select advisory group for the South Asia University being set up in New Delhi under the SAARC and the Regional Advisory Group for the Food and Agriculture Organization Asia and Pacific region based in Bangkok.

Dr. Malik obtained his Ph. D in Econometrics from the University of New England, Australia and a Masters degrees in Agriculture Development Economics from the Australian National University, Australia and a Masters degree in Economics from the Quaid-e-Azam University Islamabad, Pakistan.
